



## Bio: Kelvin Wetherell

Kelvin's raw, soulful storytelling and troubadour spirit shine throughout both his current record, *The Jackknife Letters*, and his bravely original, one-man live show. His music and lyrics riff on self-awareness and our commonality in a world distracted.

Kelvin's voice is timeless, inspired by such greats as Sam Cooke, Bob Marley, Freddie Mercury and Johnny Cash. His guitar style is a unique mix of finger picking and percussive, tribal elements. On stage, his honesty, humour and songwriting bring the crowd together, while his use of sound effects, psychedelic guitars and live vocal layering become part of the tale the songs tell.

*The Jackknife Letters* was recorded at the singer's home studio and was mixed and mastered at Toronto West Sound by Cory Blackburn, drummer/producer/engineer of 2016 Juno nominee Blackburn. His music has taken him to Nashville, through Europe, across the Great White North, and back.

Kelvin's energy is also devoted to being Papa to a tiny human, husband to a lovely lady and to the practice and teaching of yoga.
